From the Pastor...

It is no secret in our Great Plains Annual Conference I have long been an advocate of a more inclusive United Methodist Church. As a result, I have followed closely, especially in recent years, the continued conflict in our denomination around trying to bring our church back to a more inclusive posture regarding full inclusion of our LGBTQ siblings, members, and colleagues. I have been ever hopeful each time our General Conference has met over the thirty-two years of my ministry. I even attended the special held 2019 General Conference in St. Louis, and watched broken hearted with tear filled eyes as our beloved United Methodist Church became even more restrictive and punitive toward our LGBTQ clergy and those churches and clergy who wished to be in full ministry with them.

All this being said, it has also been heart wrenching to see so many long time United Methodist Churches and many of my clergy colleagues leave the denomination over the last couple of years in the disaffiliation process. I wish them well and bid them not ill will and hope the best for those who felt they could no longer be in ministry under the same roof, so to speak, with those who held a different view on the ministry to and of our LGBTQ siblings.

I have mentioned here at Trinity Heights more than once, this past Annual Conference for the Great Plains was one of, if not the most hopeful and hope-filled Annual Conferences I have attended in my now thirty-two years. While we grieve the loss of churches and members and clergy, my prayer is we can not move into a more hopeful future of the United Methodist Church in the coming years. Rev. Adam Hamilton, Senior Pastor, Church of the Resurrection, Leawood, KS described the hope in this way, that "we might move from a conflict driven church to a mission driven church." I do so pray!

However, Rev. Hamiliton and others, indicate of course we have not arrived, so to speak. There is much work to be done and there is still the possibility of some conflict at General Conference in 2024 and there is still much work to be done.

With this in mind and at the request of those in our Theology Discussion Group, I would like to take at least one of our group gatherings to give information, answer questions as best I can, and give an update on the current state of the United Methodist Church and the upcoming General Conference in 2024. The date for this particular Discussion Group gathering will be *Wednesday*, *November 8, 2023 at 6:15pm* following the WOW Meal. If you think of it, if you plan to attend, please let me know so I can have some sense about how many we will have in case we need to move to room larger than usual. I hope many of you will attend as we move forward into the future here at Trinity Heights United Methodist Church.
